



Texas College Accident Insurance Plan

Frequently Asked Questions



“What do I do if I am injured in an accident on campus?”

- Go to the Health Clinic for immediate medical attention.
- When appropriate, be sure to contact Campus Security and report the accident.

“Who is covered?”

- All Traditionally enrolled students.

“What is covered?”

- Accidents occurring while participating in a Texas College sponsored activity.

“What are the benefits of this plan?”

- The insurance plan will pay up to \$3,000 per covered accidental injury. The benefit period is one year, so all treatment related to your injury should be received within one year to be eligible for benefits under this plan.

“How do I file a claim?”

- To file a claim, complete a claim form and additional information outlined below and mail or fax to A-G Administrators, Inc
- Please be sure to fill out the claim form in its entirety, including the “Insurance Information” section. The claim form needs to be signed by the student as well as a Texas College representative.

“What do I need to file a claim?”

- Generally there are three items needed to file a claim:
 - A completed Claim Form
 - An itemized bill
 - An explanation of benefits from your primary insurance carrier. If you are without primary insurance, then this does not apply.

“Where do I get the claim form?”

- The claim form can be downloaded from the Texas College website under “Accident/Injury Form”
